They will also assist with the administration of the 911 civic addressing program to review new civic addressing and road name needs during development approvals.

The ideal candidate will hold a diploma or degree in GIS, Geomatics, Geography, Computer, Environmental Science or related discipline with a minimum of 2 years of GIS experience including experience with geospatial technology tools and methods, geographic concepts, cartographic principles and data models. Hands on experience and training with ESRI ArcGIS Desktop and ArcGIS Online suite of tools, such as ArcMap, ArcPro, ArcGIS Online, Story Maps, Dashboards, Web Map Applications is an asset.
